AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4741 COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE "2025 SALARY ORDINANCE" TO CREATE THE POSITION OF ARBORIST APPRENTICE

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2024, the Michigan City Common Council enacted and on October 16, 2024, the Mayor signed Ordinance No. 4741, which established the salaries and wages for appointed officials and employees for the year 2025; and

WHEREAS, since that time, the City Forester would like to create a temporary full-time position of Arborist Apprentice; and

WHEREAS, this position would be temporary in nature because the apprenticeship program would be for three (3) years only; and

WHEREAS, the City was previously awarded a \$1 Million Dollar federal grant from the USDA/Forest Service, and the City Forester has advised that said grant would fully fund the temporary full-time position of Arborist Apprentice for all three (3) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Michigan City, LaPorte County, Indiana, as follows:

- 1. The aforementioned "Whereas" sections are incorporated herein as if fully set forth herein.
- 2. Arborist Apprentice shall be created in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 4741, under the Mayor's Department and shall read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF MICHIGAN CITY FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2025

WHEREAS, the salaries for the Fire Department must be set by ordinance pursuant to IC 36-8-3-3; and

WHEREAS, previously, the City of Michigan City, through the Common Council's Labor Committee and Firefighters Local #475, on behalf of the firefighters of the Fire Department, negotiated a fair and equitable contract for the year 2022-2024 the terms of which continue until a new contract is approved by both the City and Firefighters Local #475; and

WHEREAS, due to budget constraints, the City is only able to offer a one-time bonus to employees and is unable to offer an increase to the base wages of members of the Michigan City Firefighters Local #475, thus, the base wage salaries established for the year 2024 will remain in effect for year 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Michigan City, Indiana, that:

Section 1. The salaries for the firefighters for the year 2025 shall be set as follows, subject to the terms and conditions of a labor agreement between the City of Michigan City and Firefighters Local #475:

<u>Section 2.</u> Set salaries are in effect for all payrolls issued in the calendar year governed by this ordinance.

Section 3. For purposes of 2025, a Firefighter subject to this Salary Ordinance shall be entitled to a one-time mid-year bonus in an amount up to \$1,200.00 payable the 2nd payroll in July 2025. To qualify for this bonus, a City Employee must:

- a.) Have been employed by the City in the preceding year 2024, however, if the employee was hired after July 1, 2024, their respective bonus will be prorated accordingly;
- b.) Be a full-time employee or a permanent part-time employee; and
- c.) Be actively employed by the City at the time the bonus is dispersed in 2025.
