

Advertisement for Request for Proposals (RFP)
Community Development Block Grant - Public Services 2026

The City of Michigan City, Indiana is requesting proposals for the 2026 Action Plan, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Services Projects. The City of Michigan City maximizes benefits of these funds by partnering with local non-profit organizations to conduct eligible Public Service programs. All Public Service programs must assist low-income individuals and families. Preferential consideration will be given to non-profit organizations that target services for the elderly, handicapped, and unemployed populations within Michigan City, Indiana. In addition, all Public Services must explicitly meet a **national objective** of the CDBG program such as:

- Benefit people with low and moderate incomes
- Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight
- Meet an urgent need (such as earthquake, flood, or hurricane relief)

All funding allocations are contingent upon the City of Michigan City receiving CDBG funding from HUD.

All non-profit organizations awarded funds will be monitored by the City for compliance with HUD requirements and regulations, program compliance, performance, accomplishments, eligibility, and expenditures. An on-site monitoring visit will be conducted for all non-profit organizations awarded Public Service funds.
